New Homes Bonus Allocation: Returned Funding

The Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003, hereby makes the following determination:-.

Citation

This determination may be cited as the New Homes Bonus allocation: Returned Funding Grant Determination (2014/15): No [31/2353]

1.

Purpose of the grant

2. The purpose of the grant is to provide support to local authorities in England towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred by them.

Determination

3. The Minister determines as the authorities to which grant is to be paid and the amount of grant to be paid the authorities and the amounts set out in Annex A.

Payment

4. The grant shall be payable in one instalment in May 2014.

Treasury consent

5. Before making this determination, the Minister obtained the consent of the Treasury.
