

## Annex A: Stakeholder Questionnaire

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## Background

As executive non-Departmental Public Bodies (NDPBs), both Northern Lighthouse Board (NLB) and Trinity House (TH) are required to undergo a Triennial Review to ensure that they are needed as individual NDPBs and that they are operating in compliance with the principles of good corporate governance.

This joint review covers NLB and TH in its capacity as a General Lighthouse Authority (GLA) only. This includes only those functions it undertakes as set out in Parts 8 and 9 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995 and listed in question 5. This review does not include consideration of any other activities carried out by the Corporation of Trinity House, which is a private corporation and voluntary sector body.

Whereas the Commissioners of Irish Lights are excluded from the review, answers to questions on joint operations and communications should be addressed on a tri-GLA basis.
