**Re: Freedom of Information Request** 

Thank you for your email of 14 November in which you asked for the following:

"I would like to submit a freedom of information request relating to the number and allocation of toilets within DECC.

Specifically, I would like to know whether any of Ed Davey, Matt Hancock, Amber Rudd or Baroness Verma have the exclusive and private use of any toilet facilities, which are not otherwise open to DECC officials.

If so, I would like to know the location of these toilets (which office they sit within)."

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

None of DECC's ministers have exclusive and private use of any of the toilet facilities within the department's buildings.

## Appeals procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to the Information Rights Unit (foi@decc.gsi.gov.uk).
