Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request

You asked for the following information from the Treasury Solicitor's Department ("the Department"):

Could you confirm whether any documentation bearing the surname Ford-Lloyd was discovered amongst the deceased's personal effects or on either of her two premises.

On 4 July 2011, you wrote 'Born in the City Hospital, Grafton Street, Liverpool; she was for some short time in Walton Children's Hospital'. We would be grateful if you could tell us your sources of these two statements.

We would be grateful for any suggestions you may have as to where we could obtain the deceased's original baptism record.

On 4 July 2011 you wrote 'She was admitted to Leyfield School on the 12 April 1928; and she was 3yrs 2 months on arrival at Leyfield School'. We are keen to know the source of this information.

Your request will be dealt with by the Bona Vacantia Division ("the Division") under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Division holds some of the information that you have requested.

The Division holds a short birth certificate in the name of Hilda Muriel Ford-Lloyd found amongst the deceased's personal papers. The date and place on the birth is shown as 23 March 1925, Wandsworth and it was issued on 15th April 1986.

As stated in our previous response of 4 July 2011, the Division holds an anonymous handwritten note, which was found amongst the deceased's personal papers. This is the source of the information in the three statements mentioned above.

The Division holds no further information in relation to your request.
