- 1. How many vacancies were available for promotion from Capt to Maj in the R SIGNALs in 2012, 2013 and 2014?**
- 2. How many R SIGNALs Capts were considered for promotion to Maj in in 2012, 2013 and 2014?**
- 3. How many R SIGNALs Capts were promoted to Maj in in 2012, 2013 and 2014?**

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held as follows:

note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
