2010 Standard Crime Contract (the “Contract”): Notice of extension to the Contract Period

**NOTICE OF EXTENSION TO THE CONTRACT PERIOD
OF THE 2010 STANDARD CRIME CONTRACT (THE "CONTRACT")**

This notice will be deemed to have been received in accordance with Clause 20 of the Contract Standard Terms.

Extension of the Contract Period

Pursuant to Clauses 10 and 11 of the Contract for Signature, the Contract Period is extended so that it expires at midnight on 30 June 2015.

To give effect to the extension of the Contract, Clause 8 of the Contract for Signature has been amended as follows to reflect the new date on which the Contract will expire:
