Thank you for your letter DC 5/4 dated 17 October enclosing a summary of the two Doublekay reports we have recently seen. Thank you too for arranging to obtain an extra set of these for my use.

In response to the second paragraph in your letter, I quote, below, an extract from D/AWRE's letter to me when returning your copies of the Doublekay reports.

"The documents are a selection of quotations from technical authors but in themselves are not technical in content. It is apparent that the Doublekay Organisation is strictly commercial in its outlook and it would appear that [REDACTED] has taken out some patents in association with them.

From their particular commercial position it is natural that they should be both critical and suspicious of the American policy of placing constraints on the dissemination of information and the possibility that the NPT will be used as an excuse for applying such constraints.

It is obviously reasonable that they should put a commercial point of view but one must have some doubts whether their assessment of the practicability of "micro-explosion" fusion reactors is a balanced one."

whether [REDACTED] has ever seen the detailed  
arguments (at higher classification levels).

I have been asked to comment [REDACTED], Cambridge, on whether it would be feasible to use underground explosions as a source of heat for the production of electrical power. I explained that this was, in fact, one of the early ideas put forward in the Plowshare programme but that, as far as I was aware, it was not being actively pursued at the moment.

I promised to confirm this.

I would be grateful if you could bring me up to date on this particular PNE application and for a copy of any appropriate unclassified reports that could be loaned to [REDACTED].

It would also be in our interests if I could send him a copy of any general survey of the PNE field which you might have given in the U. K.
