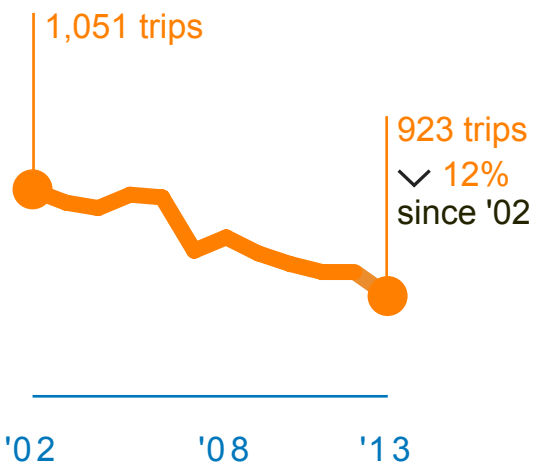
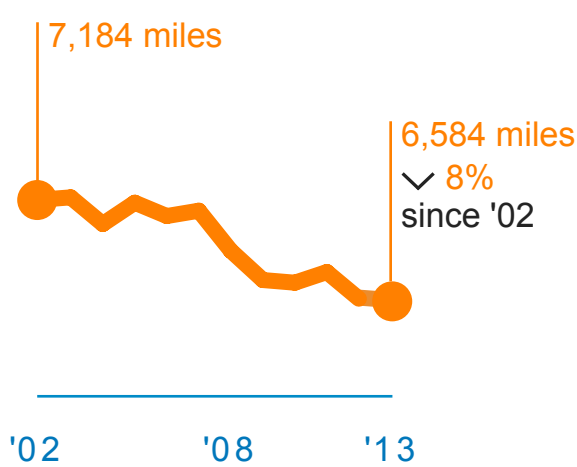

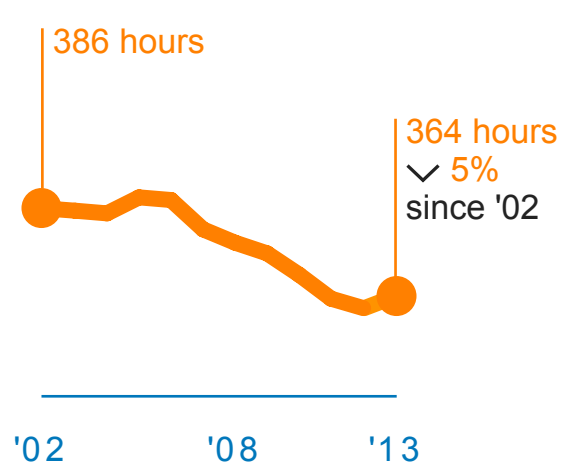
Average trips per person per year



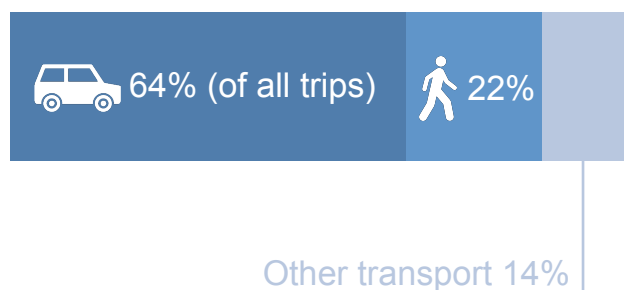
Average distance travelled per year



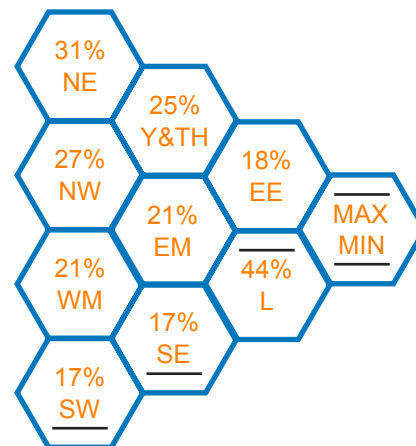
Average time spent travelling per year



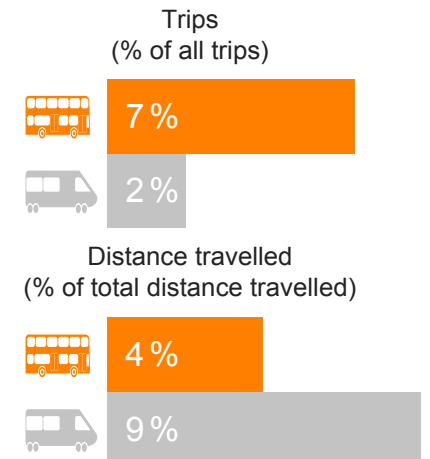

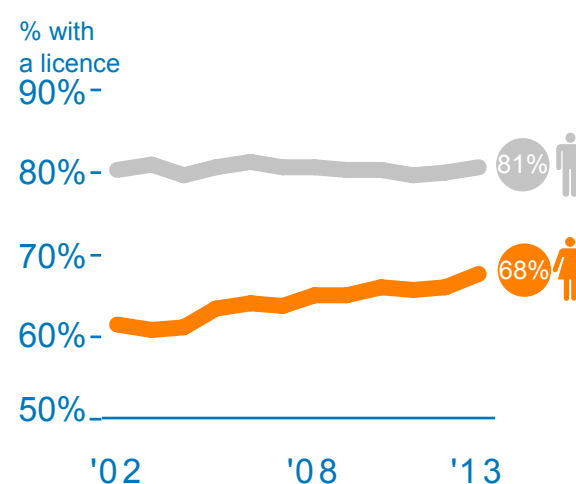

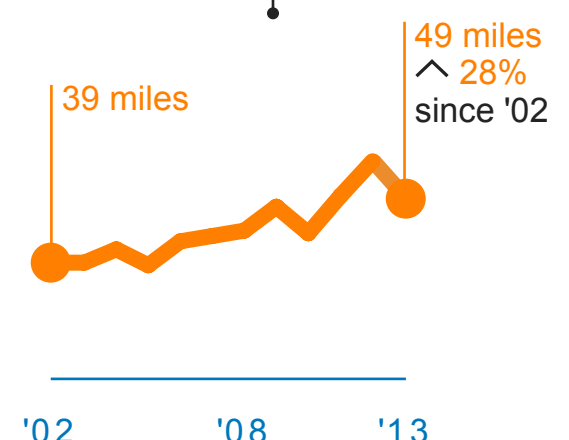

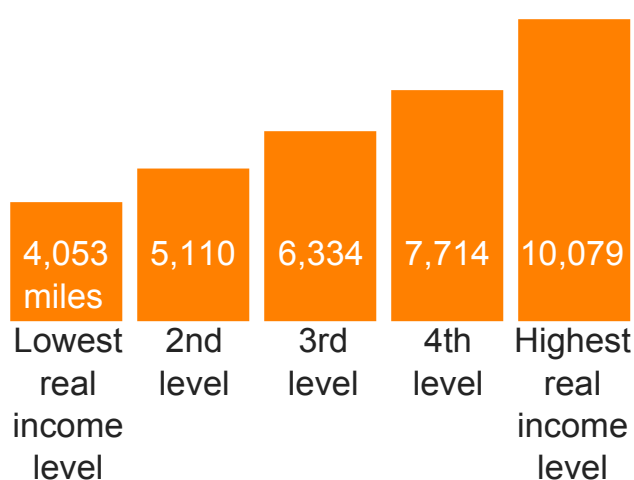

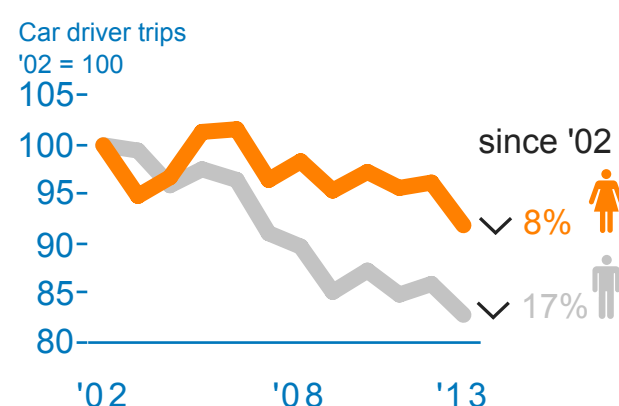
