

The Inquiries Act 2005, section 20(7)

RESTRICTION NOTICE

Pursuant to section 20(7) of the Inquiries Act 2005, the Restriction Orders (including but not limited to the General Restriction Order dated 8 September 2011) issued by Sir William Gage during the Baha Mousa Inquiry **ARE HEREBY VARIED** as set out below:

- (a) The Ministry of Defence's Iraq Historic Allegations Team (IHAT) and the Service Prosecuting Authority may be provided with the Cipher List from the Inquiry's record.
- (b) The IHAT and the Service Prosecuting Authority may be provided with unredacted copies of all witness statements given to the Inquiry and contained on the Inquiry's record.
- (c) The Director of Judicial Engagement Policy or Ministry of Defence civil servant of equal standing may, on application from the IHAT or the Service Prosecuting Authority, authorise the release of any further materials from the Inquiry's record that they require in connection with the investigation or prosecution of criminal offences arising from the death of Baha Mousa.
