#### Notes on the Table

- 1. This table presents an analysis of the assets held in taxpaying discretionary trusts. As explained in the commentary, trusts of this type are assessed for inheritance tax on each tenth anniversary of their creation. The ten years of data given in the table therefore approximates to the population of paying trusts paying inheritance tax, although some may subsequently have closed, and newly created trusts that have not yet reached their tenth anniversary will not be represented. The majority of trusts are non-taxpaying, and these are also excluded.
- 2. The estimates in this table for 2003-04 to 2011-12 have been updated since the previous version was published.
- 3. The estimates in the table are subject to further revision, particularly for the later years, as more information becomes available. It is expected that the estimated number of taxpaying trusts in 2012-13 will increase when this extra information is available.
