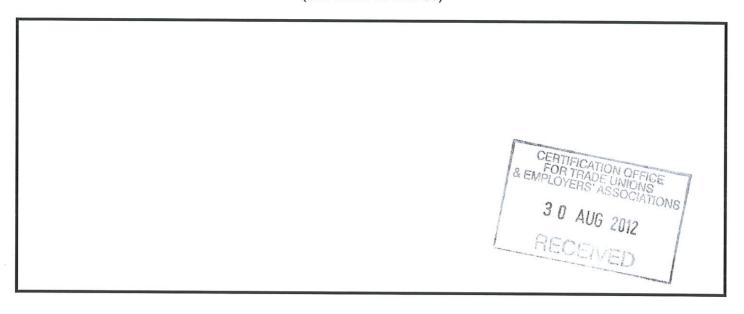

To the members of the South West Council

We have audited the accounts set out in Form AR27, pages 3 to 15, which have been prepared in accordance with the Guidance set out therein.
