There have been significant representations from Islington Borough Council about the need for the free school. The council is strongly opposed to the establishment of Whitehall Park School and state that there is no need for additional primary school places in this area through to 2023 and beyond. They believe that establishing the free school would impact on local schools by creating surplus places. However, the impact assessment data demonstrates that none of the primary schools in the immediate vicinity of the proposed free school had any surplus places at entry level in 2013 and that only one school might feel a moderate impact.
