Your email dated 12th January 2015 is considered to be a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You requested the following information:

Having looked at UK.Gov website and the Annual Statistical Finance Bulletin 1.01, I am seeking further information on IT spend. I would like to know what the most up to date figures are for Government spending on IT with SMEs in 2013/14 for:

- *Ministry of Defence*

I can confirm that the Ministry of Defence (MOD) holds some information relevant to your request. The table below details the latest recorded MOD spend with Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (SMEs), by category as defined by the Crown Commercial Service (CCS), for financial year 2013/14. The spend figures shown are for those companies who have been assessed as SMEs by Dun & Bradstreet, the UK Government's contracted partner for CCS. These figures may be subject to future alteration as not all suppliers have yet been assessed.

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
