Subject: Statistics on how many companies from 1 January 2009 - 31 December 2013 were dissolved for failing to file after various periods

Date Released: 13 June 2014

Summary of request: The enquirer requested statistics on how many companies dissolved after failure to file after; 1 year, 18 Months, 2 years, 30 months and 3 years broken from 1 January 2009 - 31 December 2013

Information released

Your request was for statistics for the period of 1st January 2009 through to 31st December 2014 on how many companies were dissolved after

- (a) 1 year failure to file annual returns/accounts
- (b) 18 month failure to file annual returns accounts
- (c) 2 years failure to file annual returns accounts
- (d) 30 months failure to file annual returns accounts
- (e) 3 years and beyond failure to file annual returns accounts

Unfortunately we do not calculate statistics in the format you have requested in your question.

However we do publish the Companies Register Activities, recorded in this are the amount of companies that have been struck off and dissolved, this can be found in Table C1. This can be accessed via the following link:
