Thank you for your email sent to the Scotland Office on 21 February 2014.

You asked for the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000:

- 1- *How many PCs (desktops, laptops, tablets) does your department/authority currently run in total? (Please provide a breakdown eg: desktops: 1,000, laptops 5,000 etc)*
- 2- *On which operating systems do these devices run? (Please provide a breakdown eg. Windows XP: 5,000, Windows 7: 8,000, Windows 8, 1,000, Linux: 200)*
- 3- *On 9 April 2014, how many PCs will you have running on Windows XP?*
- 4- *Are you in the process of migrating these devices off Windows XP? If so, to which operating system are you upgrading them? And when do you expect the migration process to be complete?*

If you are dissatisfied with the decision made in relation to your request you may ask for an internal review. A request for an internal review should be addressed to:

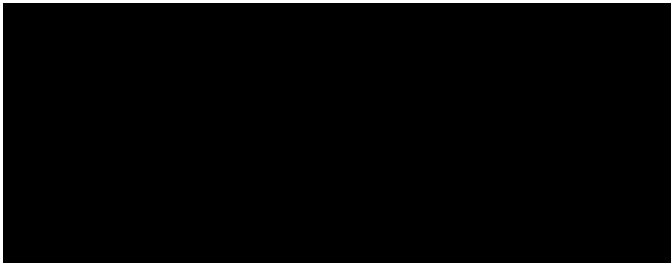
