



**DIRECTIONS UNDER S.30 CUSTOMS & EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT 1979**

The Secretary of State and the Director of Border Revenue, in the exercise of their functions in relation to general customs matters and customs revenue matters under sections 1 and 7 respectively of the Borders Citizenship & Immigration Act 2009, and in the exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 30 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979 and all other powers in that regard, direct as follows -

1. If so instructed by any proper officer, the responsible person shall remove any goods to which section 30 applies to such place as that officer shall specify.
2. Where any person moves any goods to which section 30 applies, they shall do so in accordance with such conditions and in such manner as may be specified by any proper officer.
