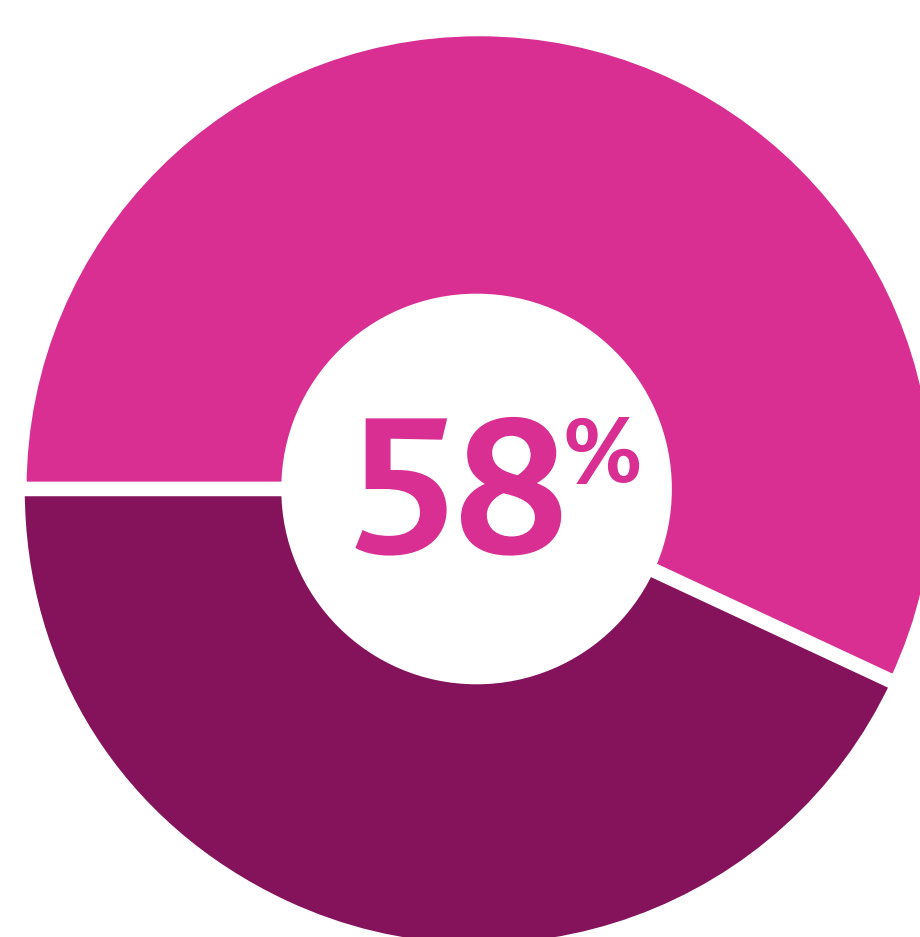


National Job Confidence Increases



The latest National Careers Service Job Confidence Index reveals that overall job confidence has increased 3.6 points since August 2013. The main driver of this is the economic recovery.

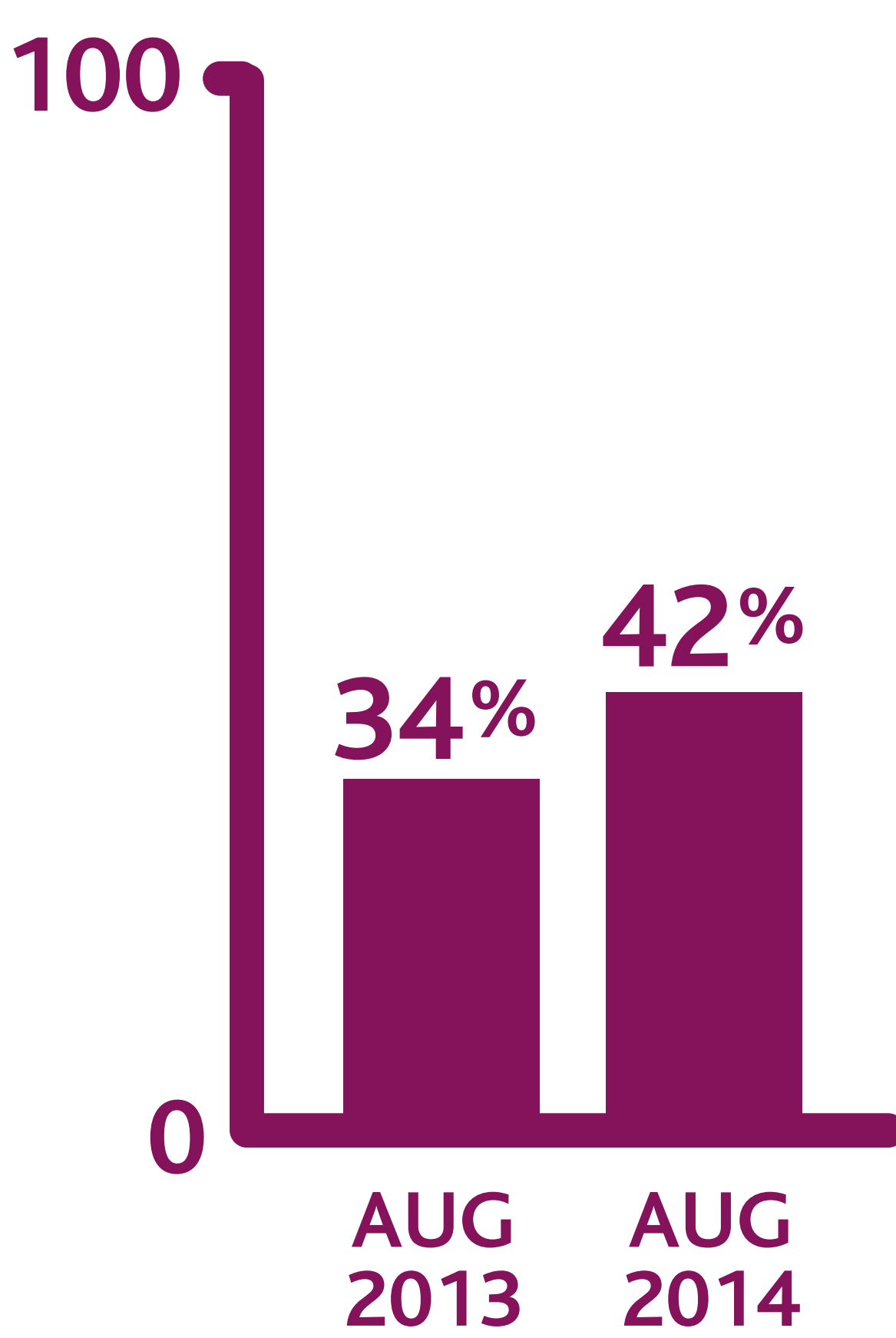


58% of people claim they are more job confident as a result of an improving economic climate.



Overall, the Index shows that four out of five people (80%) became more job confident or maintained the same confidence levels in their job and ability to find work since August 2013, an increase of 6 percentage points since the first Index in August 2013.

However, when it comes to job interviews, the Index reveals that job seekers may need more help.

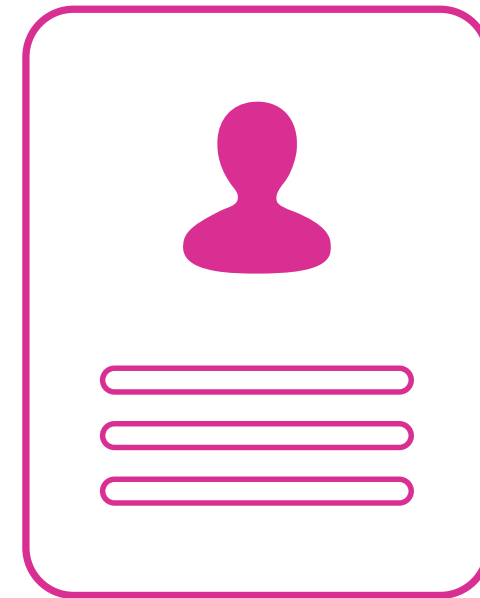


42% of people do not feel confident in being interviewed for a job. Compared to 34% in August 2013.
