M1 JUNCTIONS 10-11 NORTHBOUND SPEED LIMITS DISPLAYED

Thank you for your email of 20 June to my colleague, Gemma Timson, clarifying your request for information.

You ask for confirmation of the speed limit displayed on the M1 between junction 10 and 11 northbound between 08:30 and 09:00 on 6 February 2014.

I confirm we do hold the information and this is attached.

The following legend will help you understand the data included in the attachment:

- Equipment Reference – M1 = M1 motorway, next 4 numbers = marker post ref, next letter advises carriageway, last number advising the indicator on the gantry
- 50R = Enforced 50mph speed restriction set
- 60R = Enforced 60mph speed restriction set
- NR = No restriction (National speed limit: 70mph)
- OFF = No display
