Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request/Follow up

You asked for the following information from the Treasury Solicitor's Department ("the Department"):

Your response to our Fol request is ambiguous. You refer to information that can be found on the Grant of Letters of Administration. As we had already made reference to our knowledge of the Grant issued to TSol in 2002, we assume that you are referring to a subsequent Grant.

If there has been a second Grant, please provide a copy, or at the very least, details of the date and place of issue.

If you were referring to your 2002 Grant, please explain why the estate is no longer claimable if this Grant has not been revoked.

If a claim has been admitted, please advise when this occurred, the relationship of the claimant to the deceased, and contact details so that we might submit our claim.

Your request will be dealt with by the Bona Vacantia Division ("the Division") under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Division holds all the information that you have requested.

The Grant of Letters of Administration to the Treasury Solicitor was revoked on 25 October 2012

The Treasury Solicitor admitted the claim of an entitled relative of the deceased on 17 October 2012.
