PROPOSED REVISED FUNDING 2013-2015

Following your recent 'phone conversation with Peter Karpinski, I am writing to propose a change to the grant allocation for the maintenance and security of Marlborough House for the financial years 2013-14 and 2014-15.

As you are aware, as part of the plans for savings set out by the Chancellor in the Budget, DCMS's resource budgets will reduce by a further 1 per cent in each of 2013-14 and 2014-15. Ministers have decided to share these reductions with the Department's arm's length bodies.

Ministers are very grateful for the role that the Royal Household plays in the upkeep of Marlborough House, and in looking for efficiencies. In line with similar savings to other areas within DCMS's budget, Ministers would like to include the Marlborough House Grant in these savings. We anticipate success in reducing security costs, so hopefully absorbing such savings will not be difficult.

We therefore propose a budget cut of 1.09% and 1.06% to the resource grant for Marlborough House in 2013-14 and 2014-15 respectively. Subject to the Royal Household's agreement, the revised grant allocation would be as set out in the table below:
