I wanted to say how much I am looking forward to joining the programme of talks meeting on Tuesday 16 September. I would like to continue the talks in the format that has already been agreed. I know that previous discussions have been helpful in identifying some concrete ways in which we can implement policy better and believe there is a great deal more we can usefully discuss.

One issue I particularly want to focus on with you is what more might be done to address the unnecessary workload sometimes experienced by teachers.
