Please can I receive an up to date list of all the subcontractors, suppliers and consultants involved in Scheme comprises the improvements the A14 trunk road between Cambridge and Huntingdon. Proposals include:- A new dual carriageway southern bypass around Huntingdon extending from the A14 at Ellington to a new junction at Swavesey and extends to the Milton junction on the Cambridge Northern Bypass. Tolls would only apply on this new section of road. Widening the A1 between

Alconbury to a new junction south west of Brampton. Widening the existing A14 between the proposed junction at Swavesey to Girton. Improving the Girton junction. Widening the Cambridge Northern Bypass between Histon and Milton existing A14 through Huntingdon and demolishing the road viaduct.
