Aylestone Business and Enterprise College is 1 mile away from the permanent site and has a large surplus of 19% in 2011-12. Out of 150 places available in year 7, the number on roll was 95, showing a 37% surplus at entry point. Performance is below the Government's floor targets yet the school received a good judgement from Ofsted when it was inspected in October 2011. 5 pupils

are joining the free school from Aylestone Business and Enterprise College in September 2013. The Hereford Academy is 1.6 miles from the permanent site and has a large surplus of 16% in 2011-12. Out of 180 places available in year 7, the number on roll was 133 in 2011/12, showing a 26% surplus at entry point. Performance is 1% above the Government's floor targets yet the school received a good judgement from Ofsted when it was inspected in June 2011. 3 pupils are joining the free school from Hereford Academy in September 2013. The free school is taking 12 pupils out of home education in the first year and from 21 different schools in Herefordshire. The curriculum on offer at the Free School increases the diversity of provision in the area. Taking into account the above information we believe the opening of the free school could potentially have a moderate impact on Aylestone Business and Enterprise College and the Hereford Academy however the Free School is unlikely to affect the long term viability of these schools.
