In August last year we circulated for your comments, a draft screening assessment for the blocks applied for in the 27th Seaward Licensing Round of the potential to cause significant effects on Natura 2000 sites. The screening concluded that 61 blocks or part blocks should be further assessed before licensing decisions are taken. We have now completed draft Appropriate Assessments for the 61 blocks, which are contained in 7 stand alone documents covering the:

- Southern North Sea
- Outer Moray Firth
- Central North Sea
- West of Shetland
- Northern Ireland
- Eastern Irish Sea and
- Central English Channel
