We were asked:

Q1. How much money in total has been spent on Computer Technology, Systems and Services within your Department over the last 10 financial years and how much of this budget has been spent on failed systems and services?

We replied:

A1. The Wales Office was established in July 1999. There are no records held for computer technology, systems or services expenditure before 2005/06. The Department's IT is provided by the Ministry of Justice and the costs are set out below:
