It also includes an assessment of the significant estimates and judgments made by the governing body in the preparation of the financial statements, and of whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the organisation's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

We planned and performed our audit so as to obtain all the information and explanations which we considered necessary in order to provide us with sufficient evidence to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or other irregularity or error. In forming our opinion we also evaluated the overall adequacy of the presentation of information in the financial statements.

#### Opinion

In our opinion the financial statements give a true and fair view of the state of the organisation's affairs as at 31 December 2012 and of its income and expenditure in the period then ended and have been properly prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.
