In your answer to this request, could you please provide:

- Yearly breakdowns showing the number of senior citizens aged 65 and over who have been arrested since 1 January 2009 up until the date this request was received.
- Their ages and why they were arrested.
- Outcome of arrest: i.e. details of any fines, police cautions, prosecution, length of arrest sentence".

I can confirm that the Ministry of Defence Police holds information on this subject.

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
