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## SAFEGUARDING TRAINING

At the request of Head Teacher colleagues, I said I would publish a reminder about safeguarding training requirements.

**LEVEL 1** Induction to safeguarding. This is in pack form, it is mandatory and it is delivered by you (ie Designated Senior) to all new staff, within two weeks of starting work. I distributed a recommended pack with my newsletter earlier in the month, which you can add to or amend. I attach again for ease of reference.

**LEVEL 2** Single agency training. This is a one day face to face event delivered by the Education Social Work Team, for all staff. Dates are negotiated directly with the team. **This needs to be completed within 12 weeks of starting work and updated every three years.**

Single agency update training. This is approximately a 1 ½ hour event, often delivered in a twilight session by the Education Social Work Team, and negotiated directly with them.

**LEVEL 3** Multi agency safeguarding training. This is a one day event, published in the SCB Training Planner. All Designated Seniors and Deputies must attend this (of benefit also to other SLT members) and update every two years (minimum). How you update, is flexible, by attendance at the Designated Seniors Development Day (scheduled for 11 November), or other events advertised in the SCB planner, e.g. case conference training.

A comment about **DBS checks (CRBs previously)**, although Ofsted don't require these to be updated, it is a requirement under SOBF(G) 3352 that these are **updated every five years**. For staff in post over five years, they need additionally to complete BFG Form 33 Reliability Check (available through the Employment Disclosure Office). Updated versions of Form 33 paperwork were recently distributed by Alan Oliver, Employment Disclosure Office.
