

Annex B: Impact assessment for Holy Trinity free school

Primary – An assessment of the impact on the primary schools within 1 mile of the proposed Holy Trinity School

There is strong parental demand for this all through free school which suggests that there will be moderate impact to the local community primary schools. Parents from faith backgrounds will be unlikely to choose Holy Trinity as their children's school.

We judge that the specialist nature of this school means that parents will be unlikely to send their children to Holy Trinity.
