

NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 01 of 2015

HARBOUR OF RYE

MARINE DREDGING

Mariners are advised that dredging is planned to commence

19 January 2015

Maintenance dredging will take place at the following locations:-

- 1) Strand Quay
- 2) Strand Approach
- 3) Bridge point/River Brede sluice
- 4) Rock Channel.
- 5) Simmons Quay.
- 6) Confluence River Rother/ Rock Channel (Western Point)
- 7) Rye Wharf "Turning Circle" (east side)

Hydrodynamic dredging is expected to last for 7 days, working day and night, and will be completed using a pump barge under the control of a small tug unit.

The dredging barge and tug will display shapes and lights as required by the "Collision Regulations"

Mariners are requested to give the dredger a wide berth and pass at slow speed obeying any instructions given by the dredging master.

Both craft will be manned at all times keeping a listening watch on VHF channel 14
