### Information released:

This information is not held. In line with Government policy, the UK Commission does not take out insurance. To comply with our duty to provide advice and assistance, we have reproduced below an extract from the UK Commission's Certification of Exemption from Employer's Liability Insurance which explains the reason for this:

'The Government does not normally insure its risks. This is because, given the profit an insurer would expect to make, it is almost always cheaper for the Government not to insure and to bear any loss itself.'
