THE ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING (ENGLAND AND WALES) (BRETT AGGREGATES LIMITED) EXERCISE OF FUNCTIONS DIRECTION 2012

Citation and commencement

- (1) This direction may be cited as the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) (Brett Aggregates Limited) Exercise of Functions Direction 2012.
 - (2) It comes into force on 3rd July 2012.

Exercise of functions

- (1) Functions under the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales)
 Regulations 2010 in relation to the relevant operation are exercisable by the
 Environment Agency for an indeterminate period unless a further direction is
 issued under regulation 33(1).
 - (2) For the purposes of this direction "relevant operation" means the blending of cement in bulk or using cement in bulk other than at a construction site, including the bagging of cement and cement mixtures, the batching of ready-mixed concrete and the manufacture of concrete blocks and other cement products and directly associated activities at the premises listed in the Schedule.
