## **Revisions to Proven Re-offending Statistics Quarterly Bulletin**

Serious proven re-offending data published in Table 8 of the Proven Reoffending Quarterly Bulletin, January to December 2012

In preparing for the January 2015 publication, a compilation error was identified in one of the rows in table 8 of the previous Proven Re-offending Statistics Quarterly Bulletin published in October 2014.

This table presents re-offending data by level of seriousness, 'Serious violent/sexual re-offences' and 'Serious acquisitive re-offences'. However, this table did not account for an offender committing both types of re-offence and as such the same re-offender was counted twice in the combined 'All' figure of re-offenders. The impact of this change is presented in the attached tables.

As a result, the Ministry of Justice have today revised table 8 in the 'Proven re-offending tables' spreadsheet, to ensure accurate representation of results.
