

### **Option 1 – Proposed Approach to Use of Additional BM Units to Capture EII Volumes**

<b>Document</b>	<b>Changes Made</b>	<b>Description of Changes</b>
BSC Annex D-3	Amend 3.1 (h)	Removes the existing £100 monthly BSC charge for each Additional BM Unit (A.BMU) registered for the purpose of including EI Assets. Deleted 'or CM Assets' as the Capacity Market no longer allows metered volumes to be submitted to the CMSSP via A.BMUs. This should have been deleted as part of the previous DECC direction. This can be considered a housekeeping change as removing it has no material impact.
BSC Annex D-3	Insert 3.1(j)	Requires Suppliers to pay a charge, an 'Additional BM Unit Registration Charge', for each A.BMU registered for EII Assets. The charge is set by the [SoS after consultation with BSC Parties], and published on the BSC Website.
BSC Section F	Amend 1.1.9(c)	Protects the EII BSC Changes from the BSC Modification process, as was put in place for all other BSC changes for EMR. Changes can only be made to the BSC changes for EMR with the prior written consent of the Secretary of State.
BSC Section K	Insert 3.1.9	Restricts the use of A.BMUs registered for EII Assets to only be used for EII Assets. Requires A.BMUs for EII Assets to contain only EII Assets and EII Assets of the same Exemption Proportion. Together with 3.3.15 this has the effect of ensuring Suppliers remove EII Assets where they cease to be EII Assets e.g. from EII Certificate expiry or revocation, it also requires Suppliers to register A.BMUs for EII Assets and allocate the EII Assets to the A.BMU.
BSC Section K	Insert 3.1.10	Places time constraints on Suppliers for registering and assigning EII Assets to A.BMUs on receipt of EII Certificates. Note, Suppliers can assign EII Assets to an A.BMU quicker than the timescales below if they wish. (a) Where a Supplier does not have an A.BMU to assign the EII Assets to, it has until the latter of, 90 days after receiving the EII Certificate, or until the effective date of the EII Certificate. (b) Where the Supplier has an A.BMU registered for EII Assets in the GSP Group where the EII is, and the A.BMU will be comprised of EII Assets with the same Exemption Proportions, the Supplier has until the latter of, 30 days after receiving the EII Certificate, or the effective date of the EII Certificate.
BSC Section K	Insert 3.1.11	Places time constraints on Suppliers for registering and assigning EII Assets to A.BMUs on a Change of Supply event, or where the EII's exemption proportion changes.. Note, Suppliers can register A.BMUs in advance of its Supply Start Date, so that the EII Assets are assigned to the A.BMU from its Supply Start Date. Where a Supplier gains an EII customer and does not have an A.BMU to assign the EII Assets to, it has 90 days after the Supplier Start Date to do so. Where a Supplier gains an EII customer and does have an A.BMU registered for EII Assets in the GSP Group where the EII is, and the A.BMU is comprised of EII Assets with the same Exemption Proportions, the Supplier has 30 days after the Supplier Start Date to assign the EII Assets. Where an EII's exemption proportion changes and the Supplier does not have an A.BMU to assign the EII Asset to, the Supplier must move the EII Asset into a 'non-EII' A.BMU and register and allocate the EII Asset to an A.BMU within 90

		<p>days of the exemption proportion changing.</p> <p>Where an EII's exemption proportion changes and the Supplier does have an A.BMU registered for EII Assets with either EII Assets of the same exemption proportion, or has no EII Assets in it, the Supplier has 30 days from the exemption proportion changing to allocate the EII Assets to the A.BMU. In the meantime, the Supplier, in accordance with 3.1.9, must move the EII Asset to a BM Unit not registered for EII Assets (e.g. Base BM Unit), so that it does not receive the exemption benefit.</p>
BSC Section K	Insert 3.1.12	This clause is designed to make it explicit that EII Assets can only be assigned to A.BMUs registered for the purposes of EII Assets i.e. those A.BMUs registered with a 'D_ '.
BSC Section K	Insert 3.3.15	This requires Suppliers with EII customers to register A.BMUs and assign the EII Assets to those A.BMUs in accordance with Section K.
BSC Section K	Insert 3.3.16	Requires Suppliers to provide details of the addition or removal of EII Assets from an A.BMU. More details are contained in BSCP503 3.5.6.
BSC Annex X-1	Insert four new terms in the General Glossary	Inserts four new terms in the General Glossary: Additional BM Unit Registration Charge; EII Asset; EII Certificate; EII Regulation; and Exemption Proportion.
BSCP503	3.4.2.3A	Housekeeping change to align the units of energy, from MWh to kWh, to the DTC data flows, that the HHDA is required to provide under the Capacity Market to the CMSSP.
BSCP503	Insert 3.5.6	Consequential change from Section K 3.3.16. Requires Suppliers to provide details of the addition or removal of EII Assets from an A.BMU following a successful BM Unit allocation.
BSCP509	Amend 4.4.1	Clarifies that the registration of A.BMUs for EII Assets is initiated by Suppliers (as opposed to BSCCo or CFDSSP) and must use the entity 61 form. It also clarifies that A.BMUs being registered in MDD must follow a naming convention as published on the BSC website.
BSCP15	Insert 1.10	Provides an overview of the registration process for BM Units for EII Assets registered in CVA and SVA.
BSCP15	Amend 3.4	Clarified which A.BMU registration process should be followed for EII Assets.
BSCP15	Amend 3.5	Clarified which A.BMU de-registration process should be followed for EII Assets, CFD Assets and non-EII and non-CFD Assets.
BSCP15	Amend 3.18	Clarified which A.BMU registration process should be followed for EII Assets, CFD Assets and non-EII and non-CFD Assets.
BSCP15	Amend 3.19	Clarified which A.BMU de-registration process should be followed for EII Assets, CFD Assets and non-EII and non-CFD Assets.
BSCP15	Amend 3.20	Housekeeping change to provide correct references in table.
BSCP15	Insert 3.21	New Registration process to register A.BMUs for EII Assets.

BSCP15	Insert 3.22	New de-registration process for A.BMUs for EII Assets.
BSCP15	Amend 4.1	Added a tick box option for registering A.BMUs for EII assets to the registration form.
