



## Monthly UK Sea Fisheries Landings: September 2014

### Note to users

Data for the current year will be affected by lags in getting data finalised on our systems. This will affect the year on year comparisons as the 2013 data are more complete. Please refer to Explanatory Notes point 9 for further details.

### Key points

- The total quantity of **landings into the UK by UK vessels** for the period January to September 2014 has increased by 7 per cent compared with the same period in 2013. This was driven by a 51 per cent increase in mackerel landings, a result of the large increase in quota for this species.
- **UK fleet landings abroad** are 16 per cent higher for the year to September. This is also due to a large increase in mackerel landings, up by 54 per cent.
- In September, 38 per cent of all **UK fleet landings** were herring, 70 per cent being landed abroad. The accompanying dataset shows that almost half of this was into Norway. The mackerel season will resume in October.
- The average price for **landings into the UK by UK vessels** for the period January to September 2014 has increased by 5 per cent compared with the same period last year.
- The average price for haddock **landed into the UK by UK vessels** for the period January to September 2014 is 24 per cent higher than in the same period last year. The average price of mackerel is up by 14 per cent to 97p per kilo, despite the large increase in supply. Shellfish prices increased by 14 per cent. Cod prices fell by 1 per cent and sole and herring prices are down by 5 and 25 per cent respectively.
- **Foreign vessels landing into the UK** accounted for 22 per cent of all landings into the UK during September.
- **Landings abroad by UK vessels** accounted for 36 per cent of all landings by UK vessels during September.
- In January to September 2014, the **UK fleet landed** 111 thousand tonnes into Peterhead. This is three times the quantity of landings for Lerwick, the second highest port. The English port with the highest landings is Newlyn (8,200 tonnes).

## **Background**

This notice provides an overview of the weight and value of landings by UK vessels into the UK and abroad, and by foreign vessels into the UK. The data are based on those landings data to date that have been fully validated. Final figures for the year will be provided in our annual UK Sea Fisheries Statistics publication, released in September.

Comparisons of monthly data should be made with care due to timing lags in the data.

## **Revisions Policy**

Revisions to previously published figures for individual months are not provided in this release. However, the figures in this month's release and the accompanying dataset are the latest currently available.

## **Explanatory Notes**

1. Quantities are shown in terms of the live weight of the fish caught.
2. The values shown are based on information from first-hand sales of fish to all outlets, i.e. for human consumption as well as other uses, such as fishmeal and animal feed.
3. The calculation of average prices excludes landings with zero value to better reflect the price of the fish.
4. The category 'Other demersal' includes fish roes and livers.
5. Data include figures for the Isle of Man fleet and landings by some of the larger Channel Islands' vessels. Relatively small amounts of landings by the remainder of the Channel Islands' fleet are not included. Landings into England in Table 7a exclude data for these islands.
6. The individual ports reported in this publication represent those ports which were identified as the top 20 UK ports in terms of quantity landed or the top 20 UK ports in terms of value of landings, in the annual publication - UK Sea Fisheries Statistics 2012

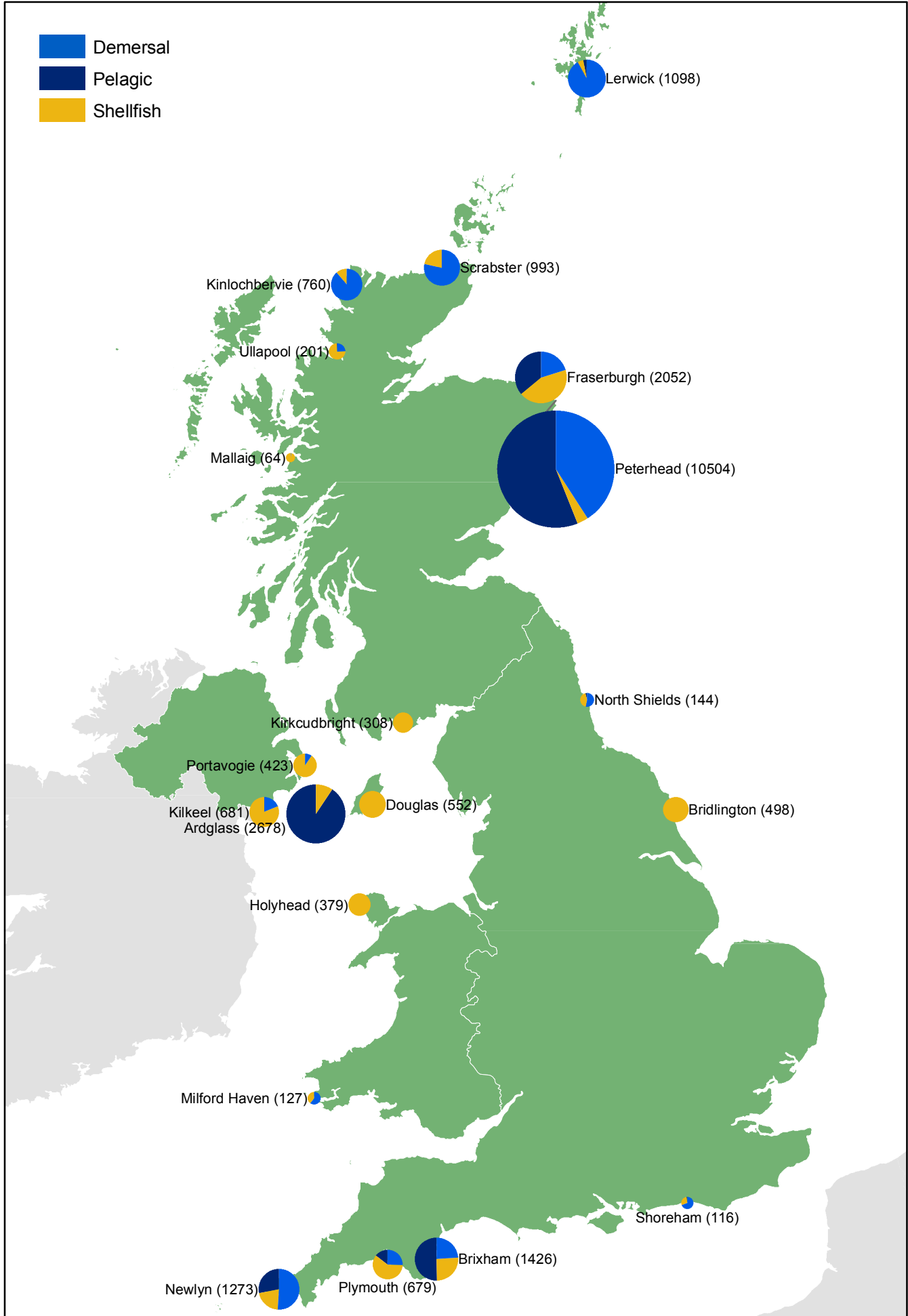

7. Landings by foreign vessels into the UK do not include carrier landings. These are however included in our annual publication (see link above).
8. Details of the methodology can be found at <https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/monthly-uk-sea-fisheries-statistics#methodology>
9. Data are based on landings data to date which have been fully validated. The summary tables include a year on year comparison of cumulative landings up to and including the latest month. However, the later year's figures will be less complete due to delays in getting all landings data onto the system, and this will have an effect on the percentage change figures shown. Whilst the size of this effect varies by species, a rough guide is that at the total levels, the percentage change shown could be out by up to 5 percentage points, based on analysis of the Monthly Returns published throughout 2013.
10. The following symbols apply throughout:
  - means "nil"
  - .. means "negligible" (less than half the last digit shown)
  - na means "not applicable"

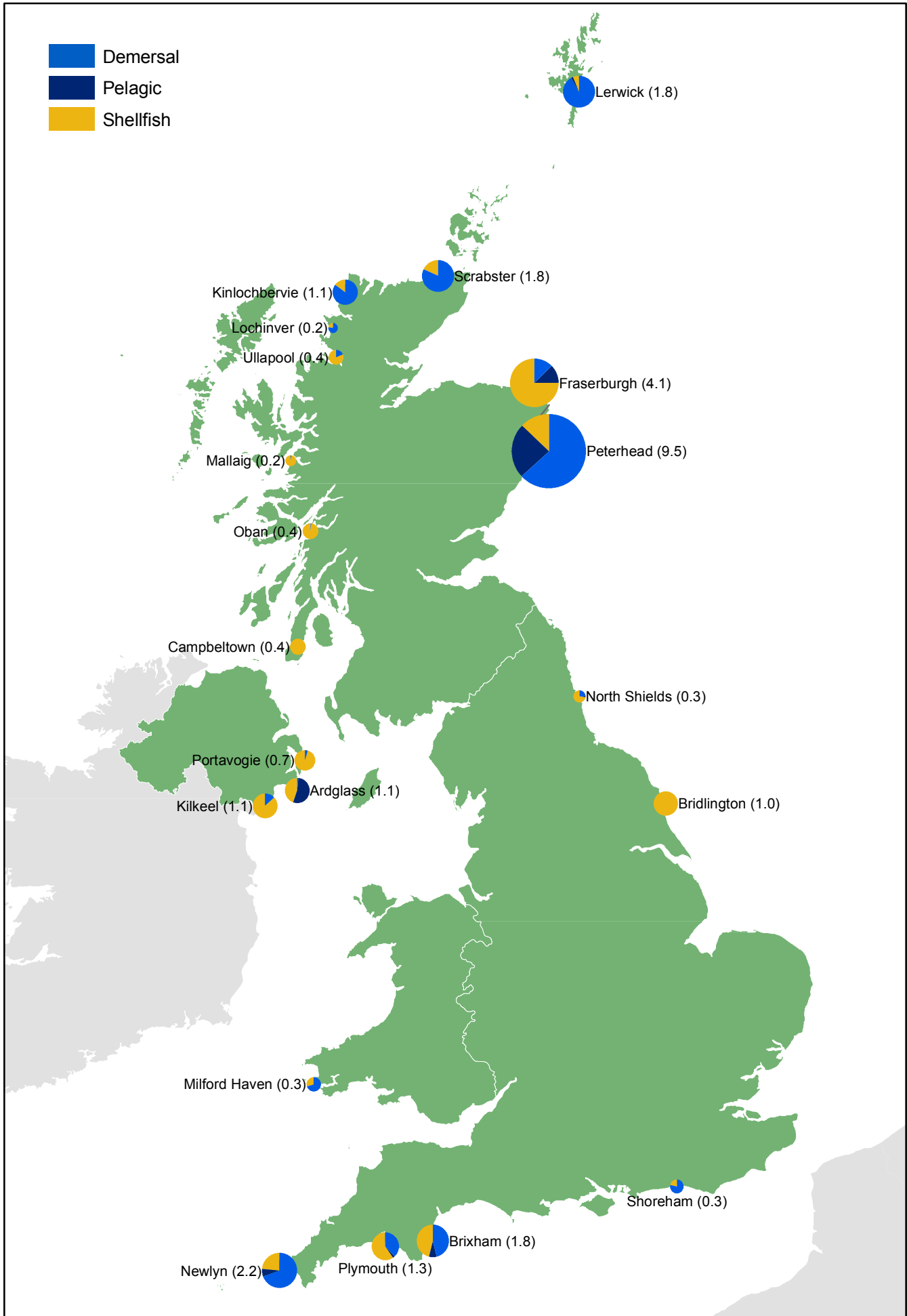
