Please could you break down the information with regard to:

- The person's age
- The person's gender
- The city they took the test in
- The dates (month/year only) of the tests

The tables below show the top twenty number of attempts taken to pass either the car practical or car theory test. The number of attempts includes all attempts taken since 2004 which is the earliest date for which we hold electronic records.

Whilst we hold information about the month in which the test was taken, this could lead to the identification of an individual and become personal data as defined by the Data Protection Act. This information is exempt from release under section 40 (2) (personal information) of the FoIA as release of the information would not be fair to the individual concerned. A copy of this exemption is attached at Annex A.
