Yes, we can confirm we have advised forces to follow the regulations and (since they do not currently cover ESA) by implication not deduct the ESA.

We haven't yet issued further guidance because we are still not in a position to say when we will be able to change the regs to allow deduction, nor what the position will be in respect of retrospection etc. We will do that asap.

Following your post on the Police Pensions Online community I have attached a letter received from one of our pensioners which he has advised he received from yourselves.

As you can see it does quote the paragraphs from the website but it also specifically states

We have restated that on an online forum for police pensions practitioners and we have responded to a number of individual queries with advice to adhere to the regulations. The regulations do not currently cover ESA so we would expect forces to stick to the regulations and not deduct the ESA.

South Wales Police are, like many other Forces considering the way forward with the deduction of ESA, however the above instruction seems to make a determination for Forces to follow.
