AMENDMENTS TO VERY HIGH COST CRIME LEGAL AID CONTRACTS – EFFECTIVE FROM 2 DECEMBER 2013

The Lord Chancellor is making legislative changes in order to set out all the fees relating to existing and future very high cost case (VHCC) Crime Contracts in secondary legislation, which will come into force on 2 December 2013, subject to Parliamentary approval. The legislative changes will be made and laid before Parliament from 1 November 2013 and can be found at http://www.legislation.gov.uk/new.

As the fees will be set out in secondary legislation, the LAA has removed, from 2 December 2013, all fees from the following existing VHCC Crime Contracts held by providers¹, following consultation with the Consultative Bodies:

- 2013 VHCC Contract (for organisations); and
- 2013 VHCC Contract (for self-employed advocates) (together known in this document as "the 2013 VHCC Contracts");
- 2010 VHCC Contract (for organisations); and
- 2010 VHCC Contract (for self-employed advocates) (together known in this document as "the 2010 VHCC Contracts");
- 2008 VHCC (Crime) Panel Contract for Panel Members (including contract annexes); and
- 2008 VHCC (Crime) Panel Contract for Panel Advocates (including contract annexes) (together known in this document as "the 2008 VHCC Panel Contracts").
