Revision to Statutory Homelessness Q1 (January to March) 2014 publication

Both the statistical release and the live tables have been updated. The Statutory Homelessness Q1 (January to March) 2014 publication, which was published on 19 June, has been revised. A technical error in the production process meant that data for Q1 2014 reported by ten local authorities did not feed through into the statistics. In these instances data were estimated. We are now able to use the reported data. The local authorities that were affected are:
