




## Local summary of Legionnaires' disease in residents of England and Wales, 2013

## **Wales**

This report provides a short summary of Legionella activity in Welsh residents, with particular emphasis on cases with onset of symptoms during 2013. Data for years 2011 and 2012 and in some tables and graphs, for years 2004 to 2012, are presented for comparative purposes.






