**M1 JUNCTIONS 10 TO 13
ACCIDENT STATISTICS**

Thank you for your email of 23 November to the Highways Agency's Information Line (HAIL) in which you request data under the Freedom of Information Act.

I confirm that we do hold the information. However, under Section 21 of the Act, we are not required to provide information which is already reasonably accessible to you. The information you request is available at <http://road-collisions.dft.gov.uk/>

To help you find the information you are looking for, please access the above link through your web browser. Then select the Collision Map on the right hand side of the screen. The M1 junctions 10 to 13 are covered by two local highway authorities. You will need to select Central Bedfordshire and then Luton as the local highway authorities in the drop down selector on the left hand side under Local Highway Authority. You may then choose the Year, Severity of Casualty, Casualty Age Band and Vehicle Type from the remaining drop down selectors. When finished, please click on Submit on the right hand side of the screen.

To see a more detailed map showing accident statistics on the M1, please click on one of the coloured roundels located near the M1. This will provide you with a more detailed map view of the area and you can use the zoom functions, which work in the same way as Google maps, to highlight areas of interest. A legend explaining the coloured roundels can be found below the map.

Information has recently been included for 2013 and you can find this in the Year selector. However, data for 2014 has yet to be validated and is therefore currently unavailable.
