## **Statistical Notice**

Pre-announcing intention to publish  
final re-conviction results for cohorts 1  
of the Peterborough and Doncaster  
Payment by Results pilots

4 August 2014



## **Background**

The Ministry of Justice currently has two prison based Payment by Results pilots operating in HMP Peterborough and HMP Doncaster. The final results for cohorts 1 for these pilots will be published in a press notice at 09:30 on Thursday 7 August 2014.

The Ministry of Justice has been publishing quarterly interim reconviction figures for these pilots since June 2013. The final results for each of these pilots will be based on a 12 month re-conviction rate: offences committed in the 12 months following release from prison, and resulting in conviction at court either in those 12 months, or in a further 6 month period (allowing time for cases to progress through the courts).
