Notes

For those PCTs who are starting their programme in October 2012, the rows contain no figures. The data are broken down by England, Strategic Health Authority (SHA) and Primary Care Trust (PCT).

This information is supplied by each PCT and is submitted monthly using the Department of Health's ImmForm website. These data are subject to change; data from the monthly vaccine uptake collections should be considered provisional. The denominators for Cohort 10 are based on school roll data supplied by the Department for Education. Therefore, the vaccine uptake rates should be regarded as indicative. Annual coverage data will be collected in September 2013. It is the annual survey that will provide the formal uptake figures and will be subsequently published as final data.
