## **Changes to Court Statistics Quarterly – statement by the Chief Statistician Iain Bell**

This Statistical Notice advises users of a new table to be added to the Family Matter chapter of the Court Statistics Quarterly bulletin to be published 28 June 2012.

In summary, the proposed change is the addition of a new table showing the number and average duration of family cases completed in 2011, split by case type and by whether or not the applicant(s) and respondent(s) in the case had a legal representative.

It will be published and made available in Adobe Acrobat (pdf), Microsoft Excel (xls), and Comma Separated Values (csv) formats.
