
Buying goods and services for colleges and universities

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This issue provides you with the latest updates on buying goods and services from the Crown Commercial Service (CCS). Our compliant, money saving deals have been developed for the whole of the public sector, including colleges and universities.



Facilities Management Assurance Services

A <u>Facilities Management (FM)</u> Assurance Services agreement was launched in September providing customers with a helpdesk solution to help them manage their FM services.

The agreement complements the government-wide <u>FM Services agreement</u>, which launched in July, giving you access to a comprehensive range of FM Services including mechanical and electrical maintenance, mail services, cleaning and security.

Accessing the new FM Assurance Services agreement is straightforward. Firstly you issue a 'request for quote' to the supplier, Kellogg, Brown & Root Limited inviting them to submit a quotation. This process can be carried out on our eSourcing tool, however, as this is a single supplier agreement, we advise you to contact Kellogg Brown and Root Ltd directly to discuss your requirement.

Vehicle Hire Services

A new <u>Vehicle Hire Services</u> agreement is now live giving colleges and universities access to a wide range of vehicles including passenger vehicles, off road 4x4s and minibuses.

Features include an innovative new car sharing option, price protection for 4 years, international vehicle hire and access to electric and ultra-low emission vehicles.

The car sharing option gives you access to a shared fleet of vehicles, along with pay as you go models, which have been shown to save 20-30% in mileage, whilst also supporting the move away from the use of private vehicles.

The agreement offers a choice of 12 suppliers and can be accessed by either 'direct award' or by 'further competition' depending on your needs.

ICT Services for Education

The ICT Services for Education agreement, which was developed in collaboration with the Department for Education and the Education Funding Agency, has been created specifically for education providers. It replaces the previous BECTA agreement, providing access to specialist technology services, hardware and infrastructure.

It covers the full range of ICT goods, services and solutions needed by education providers including design, specification, supply, integration, implementation and testing, as well as training, support and maintenance. These are available together as a packaged solution or in any combination you require, helping you save both time and money.

The ICT solutions available include:

- hardware servers and user computing devices
- **software** operating systems, office productivity, network, security
- networks routers, switching, cabling, local area network infrastructures
- peripheral equipment printers, peripherals to support specialist curriculum provision audio visual equipment
- **user devices** desktop computers, tablets, high specification devices
- mobile connectivity as an integrated package within user devices

To use the agreement, you will need to run a further competition so suppliers on the agreement can provide you with a priced solution to meet your specific requirements. Our eSourcing tool is available free of charge to help you run the further competition. The section on 'useful links for accessing our agreements' below provides more details on the tool.
