RE: HORNSEA ONE OFFSHORE WIND FARM ORDER 2014 (AS AMENDED BY THE HORNSEA WINDFARM (CORRECTION) ORDER 2015), REQUEST TO VARY DEEMED MARINE LICENCE (DML) 4.

I can confirm the Marine Management Organisation (MMO) received your request for a variation to the Deemed Marine Licence within Schedule 11 of The Hornsea One Offshore Wind Farm Order 2014 (DCO) on 30 October 2015.

As the MMO is responsible for enforcing, post-consent monitoring, varying, suspending, and revoking any deemed marine licence(s) as part of the DCO, the MMO will now proceed to consider the request under <u>section 72 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009</u>. As part of this process the MMO will authorise its right to consult the relevant bodies that the MMO sees fit. It should also be noted that there will be a fee associated with the variation process, which will be issued in writing for the applicant to accept; further information regarding this can be viewed at the link below.
