Emma, it was great to meet you at the DC commemoration of the London Summit last month. Hope you are enjoying the end of summer.

I'm writing to share background on a Clinton Global Initiative Commitment to Action on girls' secondary education that Secretary Clinton is developing, in partnership with former Australian Prime Minister Julia Gillard and the Brookings Institution. It is our hope that your government would be interested in joining with other partners to make an important contribution to this effort, particularly given your strong leadership on this issue.

The focus of this Commitment to Action is turning global attention to the unfinished business in girls' education and specifically raising the global ambition so that all girls can complete secondary school with the skills they need for their work and life.

Our objective for the launch of this program is to obtain commitments from participating governments, multilateral organizations, civil society organizations, and the private sector on

specific actions they will pledge to undertake to reach girls—particularly in Sub-Saharan Africa and South West Asia—with a focus on programs in one of five broad areas:

- Getting girls into and completing secondary school
- Ensuring school safety
- Improving quality learning
- Helping transition to the world of work
- Supporting developing country leaders in girls' education

Attached is an outline of the framework with additional detail. **[Redacted]**

We hope that your government is able to make a commitment in one of these five areas and join us in September. I am happy to discuss this with you and answer any questions you may have.
