

NOTICE OF ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 119

Essex County Council

Public Path Diversion Order 2015 Footpaths 16 and 26 Barnston Footpaths 2 and 97 Great Waltham in the City of Chelmsford

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is 30 June 2016.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert a part length of the public Footpaths 2, 97 Great Waltham, 16 and 26 Barnston in the district of the City of Chelmsford.

A part of Footpath 16 Barnston starting from the field gate at grid reference 56593,21932 and running in a north easterly then an easterly direction along the existing track for a distance of 390 metres to grid reference 56630,21932 where it connects to Footpath 26 Great Waltham and then continuing in an easterly direction along the track to the parish boundary where it continues as Footpath 2 Great Waltham, for a further distance of 104 metres to grid reference 56640,21931, will be diverted to a new route 2 metres wide commencing at the same above point and running in north easterly and then an easterly direction along a route parallel to the track for a distance of 385 metres to grid reference 56629,21931, then continuing in an easterly direction for a distance of 110 metres to where it joins Footpath 7.

A further part of Footpath 2 Great Waltham starting at grid reference 56642,21962 and running in a generally southerly direction around the east side of the pond for a distance of 160 metres to grid reference 56643,21948 where it connects to Footpaths 26 and 97 Great Waltham and a part of Footpath 26 starting from grid reference 56643,21948 and running in a west north westerly direction for a distance of 56 metres to grid reference 56638,2190 and continuing in a south-westerly then southerly direction along the existing track, for a distance of 202 metres to grid reference 56630,21932 where it connects to Footpath 16, will be diverted to a new route 2 metres wide commencing at the same above point and running in a southerly direction and then a westerly direction for a distance of 115 metres to grid reference 56637,21956 and then in a

generally south south westerly direction to grid reference 56629,21931 where it will connect to Footpath 16.

A part of Footpath 97 Great Waltham starting from grid reference 56643,21948 and running in a south westerly then a south easterly and then a north easterly direction, following the line of the existing track for a distance of 140 metres to grid reference 56654,21949 at the track junction, will be diverted to a new route 2 metres wide, commencing at grid reference 56654,21949 and running in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 180 metres grid reference 56642,21962 where it joins Footpath 2.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 14 July 2016]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 25 August 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as

possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 6 October 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

We cannot accept any libellous, racist or abusive comments. Any documents containing such comments will be returned.

This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the rights of way should be diverted.

The landowner will defray all costs which are incurred in bringing the new site of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.

Chelmsford City Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act and has consented to the making of the Order.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Absol Park in the Parishes of Barnston and Great Waltham in the City of Chelmsford and shown by continuous bold black lines on the Order Plan numbered BARN 16A contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be diverted after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.

2. At the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order there shall be three public footpaths over the land situated at Absol Park in Parishes of Barnston and Great Waltham in the City of Chelmsford described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken black lines on the Order Plan numbered BARN 16A contained in this Order.

Plan No. Barn 16 A

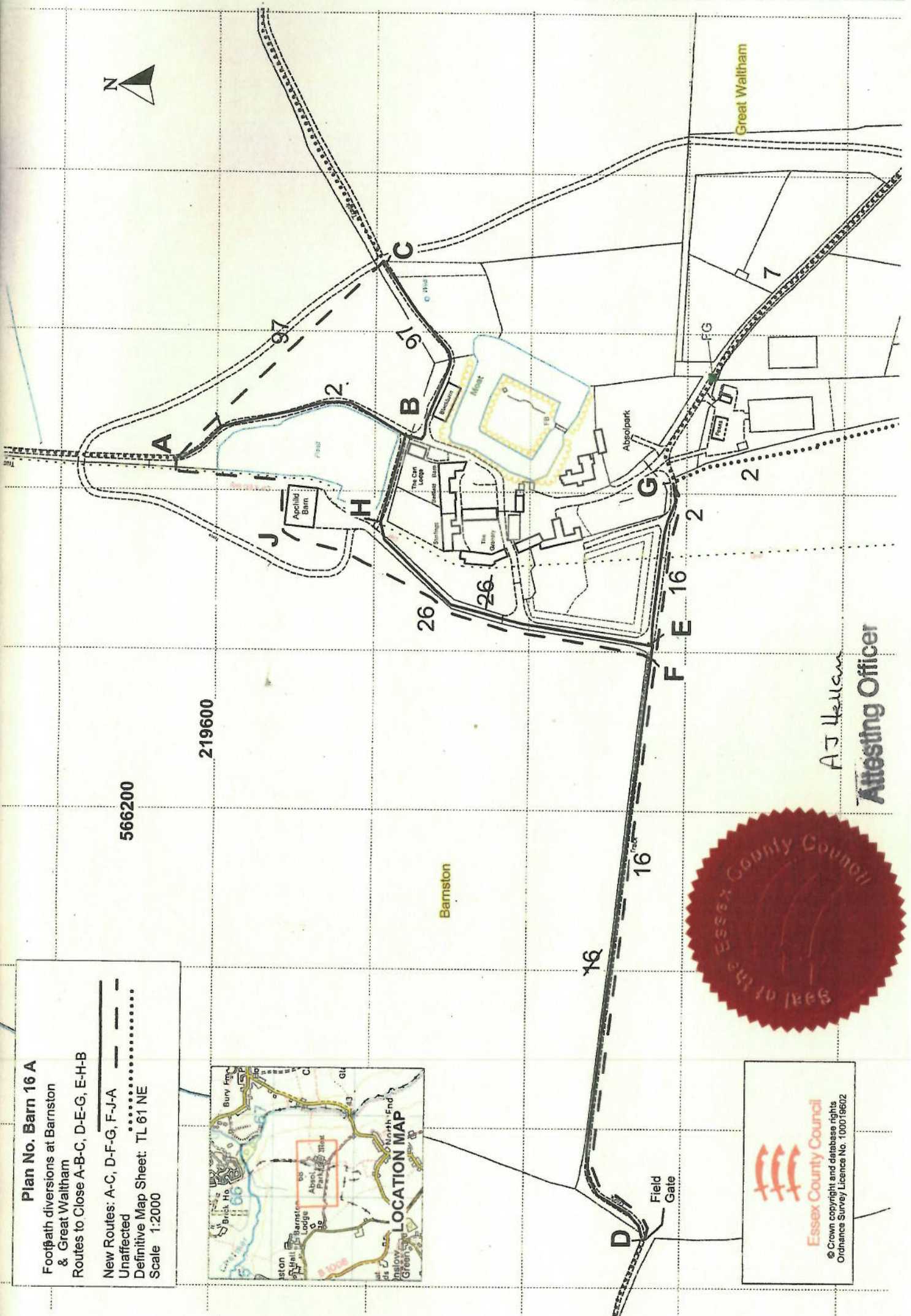
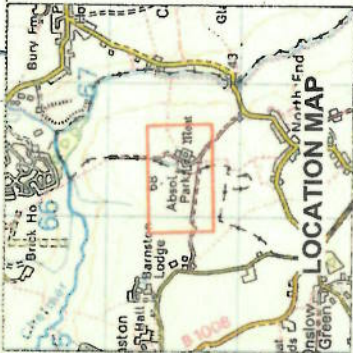
Footpath diversions at Barnston & Great Waltham

SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

Footpath 16 Barnston / Footpath 2 Great Waltham

A part length of Footpath 16 Barnston being of unknown width and shown by a continuous bold black line on the Order Plan starting from point **D** at the field gate at grid reference 56593,21932 and running in a north easterly and then an easterly direction along the existing track for a distance of approximately 390 metres to point **E** at grid reference 56630,21932 where it connects to Footpath 26 Great Waltham. It then continues in an easterly direction along the track to the parish boundary where it continues as Footpath 2 Great Waltham, for a further distance of 104 metres to point **G** at grid reference 56640,21931 where it connects to Footpath 7 Great Waltham.

Footpath 2 Great Waltham

A part length of Footpath 2 Great Waltham being of unknown width and shown by a continuous bold line on the Order Plan starting from point **A** at grid reference 56642,21962 and running in a generally southerly direction around the east side of the pond for a distance of 160 metres to point **B** at grid reference 56643,21948 where it connects to Footpaths 26 and 97 Great Waltham.

Footpath 97 Great Waltham

A part length of Footpath 97 Great Waltham being of unknown width and shown by a continuous bold line on the Order Plan starting from the aforementioned point **B** and running in a southerly(?) and then a south easterly and then a north easterly direction, following the line of the existing track for a distance of 140 metres to point **C** at grid reference 56654,21949 at the track junction.

Footpath 26 Great Waltham

A part length of Footpath 26 Great Waltham being of unknown width and shown by a continuous bold line on the Order Plan starting from the aforementioned point **B** and running in a west north westerly direction for a distance of 56 metres to point **H** at grid reference 56638,2190 and continuing in a south-westerly then southerly direction along the existing track, for a distance of 202 metres to the aforementioned point **E**.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS OR WAYS

Footpath 16 Barnston / Footpath 2 Great Waltham

A Footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold black broken line on the Order Plan commencing at the aforementioned point **D** and running in a north easterly and then a easterly direction along a route adjacent to the track for a distance of 385 metres to point **F** at grid reference 56629,21931, then continuing in an easterly direction for a distance of 110 metre to the aforementioned point **G**.

Footpath 2 and 26 Great Waltham

A Footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold black broken line on the Order Plan commencing at the aforementioned point **A** and running in a southerly direction and then a westerly direction for a distance of 115 metres to point **J** at grid reference 56637,21956 and then in a generally south south westerly direction to the aforementioned point **F**.

Footpath 97 Great Waltham

A Footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold black broken line on the Order Plan commencing at the aforementioned point **C** and running in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 180 metres to the aforementioned point **A**.
