**Termination Warning Notice to the Members and Trustees of The Education Fellowship Trust in respect of Wrenn School**

In accordance with section 2A of the Academies Act 2010<sup>i</sup> any funding agreement of an academy school may be terminated by the Secretary of State where special measures are required to be taken by the academy or the academy requires significant improvement and the Chief Inspector of Ofsted has given notice of that under section 13(3)(a) of the Education Act 2005.

I received an Ofsted notification dated 24 November 2016 confirming that, following the inspection on 18 October 2016, Wrenn School was judged to have serious weaknesses and to require significant improvement.

In making the decision on whether to terminate the funding agreement I will consider any written representations you wish to make. We will also be in touch to arrange a diagnostic Education Advisor visit for January 2017.

Please provide me with any representations you have by Friday 13 January 2017.
