All four appeared at Portsmouth Magistrates Court on Friday 23 August 2013, and then on 16 September 2013 at Portsmouth Crown Court for trial. Proceedings were adjourned and the accused were remanded on unconditional bail to appear at the Court on 18 November 2013 (only a Plea and Case Management hearing – trial will not be resumed on that date).

<u>Update</u>: pleaded guilty to the firearms charge and was sentenced on 15 November 2013 to 12 months imprisonment, suspended for 12 months.

<u>Update</u>: The main trial will resume at Portsmouth Crown Court on 7th July 2014.
